### Key Expectations for Parents & Guardians

- **Respectful Silence During Class:** The school is a place of learning and focus. We kindly request that you help us minimize noise and distractions.
  - **Phone Calls:** Please step outside to make or take any phone calls.
  - **Conversations:** Please take all conversations, especially loud ones, outside of the main training area. Even quiet conversations can be distracting to students who are trying to listen to their instructor.
- **Quiet Entry & Transitions:**
  - It is crucial to enter the school quietly, especially if a class is already in session or during the transition between classes. This helps students stay focused, maintains a disciplined atmosphere, and ensures everyone can hear important instructions.
- **Stay Informed with Announcements:**
  - Important announcements regarding upcoming events, holiday closures, testing dates, and special opportunities are made at the **start of each class**. We strongly encourage you to listen in for this crucial information to keep your family up to date.

### Supervision of Siblings & Young Children:

- For the safety of all our members and to maintain a focused training environment, we ask that siblings and young children do not run throughout the school. We welcome them to play outside under your supervision.
